II. <u>BUSINESS ITEMS</u>

A. Fastaff Crisis Staffing Assignment Commitment Agreement

Peter Spiers, CEO gave a brief background on Fastaff and the need for more nursing staff. In June 2020, SIHD lost two nurses. SIHD is looking for non-registry nurses. In efforts to get staffed Peter looked for a staffing agency. This Fastaff Crisis Assignment Commitment Agreement is an amendment to the current contract. This amendment has been reviewed by Scott Nave, Legal Counsel. SIHD needs Fastaff's services because we do not have enough nurses to cover the Emergency Department. No nurses would cause the Emergency Room to close. Even though it is onerous, Peter recommends that we keep the services with Fastaff. The goal is not to be with Fastaff for a long time. It is very difficult to get nurses in this environment. SIHD is actively recruiting through Indeed and other recruiting circles that aren't a registry.

This amendment was to address the "Nurse Cancelation" (Fastaff needs to have notification/report on a nurse if SIHD is not satisfied) and "Payments" (Payments being made in a timely manner). Section 3.3 and 4.2 are new items to the agreement.

ACTION: President Carson moved to approve the Fastaff Crisis Staffing Assignment Commitment agreement with the caveat that before Peter Spiers signs the contract that he speaks with Fastaff and asks to have the 3.3 section removed. Director Hickman seconded.

The CEO has an update on the Fastaff Crisis Staffing Assignment Commitment Agreement for the Board Members.
